- 3. Maintenance of Biotechnology, Botany and Zoology museums and Computer labs are highly appreciable.
- 4. High-end systems with networking facility and internet for all the systems is praiseworthy.
- INFLIBNET and DELNET, Research Journals & e-journals and various general Knowledge books were provided in the Library. A collection of rare books and Back volumes is exceptional.
- 6. Vocational courses in MS office & DTP are good.
- 7. Inhouse group projects by the students in various disciplines are extraordinary.
- 8. Certificates courses offered by English, Commerce, Physics, Chemistry and Biotechnology are good.
- Infrastructure facilities for Gym and Indoor with shuttle court and Table Tennis facilities are good.
